ALMOST HOME EMERGENCY SHELTER (EST. 1986)



- Shelter, childcare, and comprehensive case management for 60-90 days for families experiencing homelessness.
- 8 family units at 2 locations.
- Refer families to main number (706-354-0423) to check for availability. Parents must have kids under 18 in care.

GOING HOME RAPID REHOUSING (EST. 2013)



- One year of rental assistance including security and utility deposits along with monthly in-home case management support for families moving out of shelter.
- Families must be experiencing homelessness to qualify for program in addition to basic landlord requirements.
- If not in family shelter, refer families to do intake at HDSC (240 North Ave).

BRIDGE TO HOME TRANSITIONAL SHELTER (EST. 2019)



- Transitional shelter and quality childcare during the entirety of an enrolled student's program in qualifying educational program for student-parents experiencing homelessness.
- Parents must be experiencing homelessness, already enrolled in a higher education program, and have children under 18.
